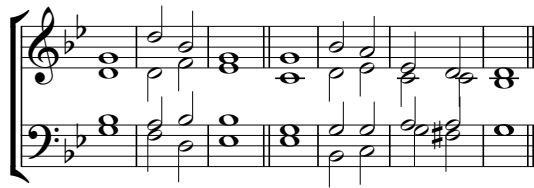


## Psalm 13

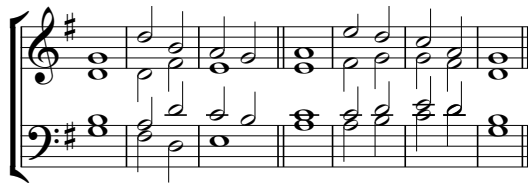


### Usque quo, Domine?

- pp** 1 How long wilt thou forget me O / Lord \* for- / ever :  
how long wilt thou / hide thy / face / from me?
- 2 How long shall I seek thy counsel in my soul \* and be so / vex'd . in my / heart :  
how long shall mine / ene- . mies / triumph / over me?
- p** 3 Consider and hear me O / Lord my / God :  
lighten mine / eyes . that I / sleep . not in / death.
- mp** 4 Lest mine enemy say \* I have pre- / vail'd a- / gainst him :  
for if I be cast down \* they that / trouble . me / will re- / joice at it.

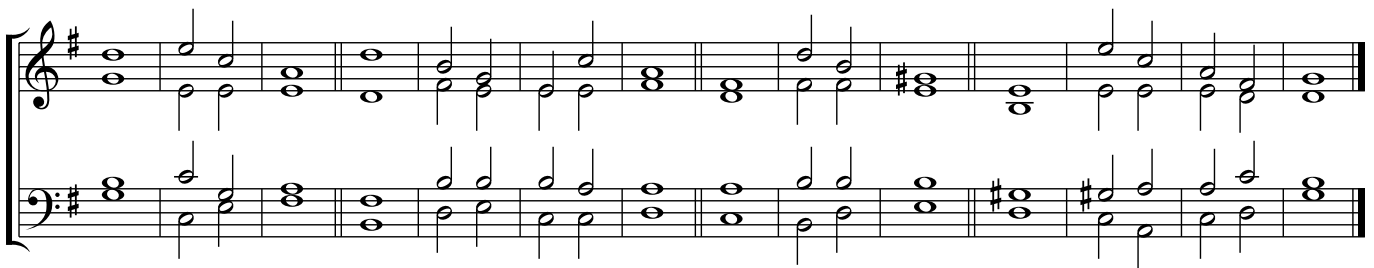


## Exaudi, Deus

- p** 1 Hear my voice O / God . in my / prayer :  
preserve my / life from / fear . of the / enemy.
- 2 Hide me from the gathering to- / gether . of the / froward :  
and from the insur- / rection . of / wicked / doers ;
- mf** 3 Who have whet their / tongue . like a / sword :  
and shoot out their / arrows . even / bitter / words.
- 4 That they may privily shoot at / him . that is / perfect :  
suddenly / do they / hit . him and / fear not.
- mp** 5 They en- / courage them- . selves in / mischief :  
and commune among themselves how they may lay snares \* and / say that /  
no . man shall / see them.
- 6 They imagine / wickedness . and / practise it :  
that they keep secret among themselves \* every / man . in the / deep of . his / heart.
- f** 7 But God shall suddenly shoot at them / with a . swift / arrow :  
that / they shall / be / wounded.
- 8 Yea their own tongues shall / make them / fall :  
insomuch that whoso / seeth them . shall / laugh . them to / scorn.
- 9 And all men that see it shall say \* / this . hath God / done :  
for they shall per- / ceive that . it is / his / work.

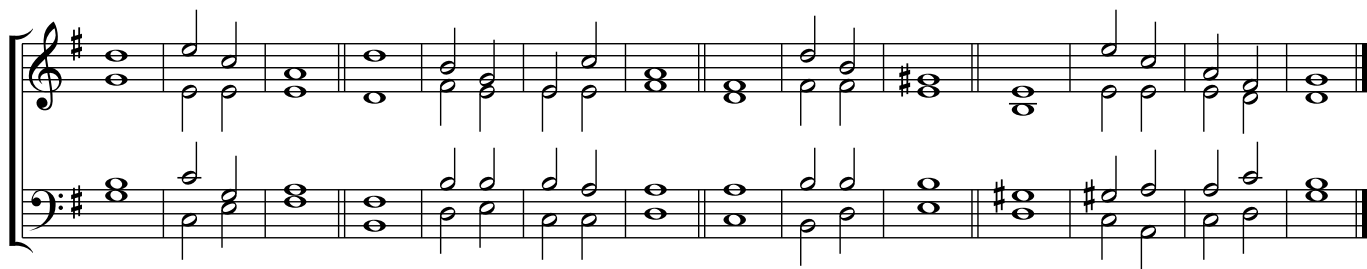

*and thy / lips . that they / speak no / guile.*

and his / righteousness . en- / dureth . for / ever.
- 4 Unto the godly there ariseth up / light . in the / darkness :  
he is / merci- . ful / loving . and / righteous.
- p** 5 A good man is / merciful . and / lendeth :  
and will / guide his / words with . dis- / cretion.
- 6 For he shall / never . be / mov'd :  
and the righteous shall be / had in . ever- / lasting . re- / membrance.
